WATER & SEWER COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES October 5, 2021

Attendance:

1. Call to Order:

Chairman Dwyer called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM in the Epping Town Hall.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag followed.

2. Approval of Minutes:

Motion by Commissioner Gauthier to approve the minutes of September 14, 2021 as submitted. Seconded by Commissioner Nickerson. Motion carried 3-0

Chairman Dwyer began by giving an update on the current condition of well D2, which is currently off-line. Grit is getting into the pump and causing damage. Underwood is working on a plan to evaluate the problem and come up with a solution.

Motion by Commissioner Gauthier to enact an outside watering ban until further notice. Seconded by Commissioner Nickerson. Motion carried 3-0.

3. Appointments: Joe Coronati of Jones & Beach came in to discuss the plan for Governor's Run, Phase 2. Eighteen units of contractor storage space are planned. The units are 30'x60' with a bathroom in each. This project was allocated 2,375 gpd previously. These units will require 60 gpd each/ 1,080 gpd total. 1,295 gpd is remaining for the last remaining lot of phase 2. Units will have individual water shut-offs and sewer cleanouts. Water and sewer connection fees of \$10,800 each are due prior to building permits being issued.

MN wants the individual owners of the units to know they are allotted 60 gpd. Add a note to the plans.

Motion by Commissioner Gauthier to approve this plan with engineer's review and a 60 gpd note on the plan. Seconded by Commissioner Nickerson. Motion carried 3-0.

John Grammas came in to discuss water and sewer for his site to the right of Walgreens. A building 10,314 sq. ft. is approved. They have no tenants yet. Four units/ retail.

TD, we have no water at this time. We would like to know the tenants. The possibility of using the well on-site until Town water is available was discussed.

4 Administrator's Report: DK requested an abatement for the Epping Car Wash of \$3,156.62 due to an unexplained high sewer bill. Their quarterly figures to not support the bill being 237K gallons higher than normal.

Motion to adjourn made by Chairman Dwyer. Seconded by Commissioner Gauthier. Motion carried 3-0. Meeting adjourned at 9:30 pm.
