



## **BE CAREFUL!**

- ))) Be safe. If you want to see fireworks, go to a public show put on by experts.
- >>>> Do not use consumer fireworks.
- Keep a close eye on children at events where fireworks are used.

## **NFPA** is opposed to consumer use of fireworks. This includes

sparklers and firecrackers. Even sparklers burn hot enough to cause third-degree burns.



## FACTS

- (!) Fireworks cause an average of almost 20,000 reported fires per year.
- (!) In 2013, sparklers caused 41% of fireworks injuries.
