WATER & SEWER COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES

July 27, 2023

1. Call to Order:

Chairman Dwyer called the meeting to order at 7:30 AM in the Epping Town Hall.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag followed.

2. Appointments: Dave Mercier and Terry Demerris of Underwood Engineers came in to discuss MAAM (Municipal Alliance of Adaptive Management).
In 2020 W&S voted not to participate and instead direct our efforts to addressing TKN ourselves.

We are now under the General Permit, with 5 years to work with MAAM. Without being in MAAM we risk being issued a TKN limit of 3mg/L when the next permit comes out.

Epping's annual contribution will be around \$12K per year.

MAAM is funding testing in and around Great Bay. They also track non-point source TKN.

MAAM meets quarterly and has templates to use for reporting.

UNH has created a map of hot spots around Great Bay to help concentrate efforts.

Brown-Caldwell represents MAAM.

Most Towns are doing this through the Planning Department to address future development. It needs to be a Town wide effort.

W&S should vote at it's next meeting to support joining MAAM. The annual cost should be split between Sewer and the Town.

Motion to adjourn made by Commissioner Nickerson. Seconded by Commissioner Pim. Motion carried 3 – 0.

Meeting adjourned at 8:30 am.
